KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

BRAC Afghanistan is providing services in Agriculture, Food Security and Livelihood, Education, Health, and is working with the World Bank on the Citizens' Charter covering overall 14 out of 34 provinces. Under the Citizens' Charter Afghanistan Project (CCAP), 435 grain banks have been set up, creating alternative food reserves for the vulnerable population during the lean season. With support from the UK's Department for International Development (DFID), the country office provides secondary, technical and vocational education for over 49,000 girls. BRAC's community health workers assist the government improving access to quality health care, especially for mothers and children.

OUR TEAM

We have a total of **1,610** staff, of whom **98%** are nationals of Afghanistan. **29%** of the total staff and **18%** of the Country Management team are women.
