KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

BRAC Myanmar was established in 2013, and is implementing three programmes: Microfinance, Emergency Preparedness and Response, Agriculture, Food Security, and Livelihood. Since inception, USD 76 million have been disbursed as loans to 131,319 borrowers (June 2019). To be disability inclusive, the country office initiated livelihood and business training, and a loan product for persons with disabilities. The registration step to receive a deposit-taking license has been taken. In 2019, BRAC successfully completed the first phase of the Myanmar Sustainable Aquaculture Project and has agreed to continue another year with the support of WorldFish and the German Corporation for International Cooperation (GIZ).

OUR TEAM

We have a total of **642** staff, of whom **96%** are nationals of Myanmar. **86%** of the total staff and **33%** of the Country Management team are women.
