



KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

BRAC Sierra Leone is complementing the efforts of the local government through four programmes: Health, Empowerment and Livelihoods for Adolescents, Agriculture, Food Security and Livelihood, and Emergency Preparedness and Response. The BRAC country office received the Most Outstanding INGO supporting Women by the National Women Achievements award in 2019.

BRAC is the largest microfinance provider by the number of clients in Sierra Leone, operating in 13 out of 16 districts.

Health	10,660 community and 3,600 school members received training on malaria awareness and prevention
Emergency Preparedness & Response (EPRP)	275 students, teachers, and community disaster management volunteers trained on disaster preparedness, first aid, search and rescue.
